2. If a continuing student has:
 - a. Completed PLAN1001 but not PLAN2005, they must complete PLAN2005 by Semester 1, 2027.
 - b. Completed PLAN2005 but not PLAN1001, they must complete PLAN1001 by Semester 1, 2027.
 - c. Not completed both PLAN1001 and PLAN2005 by Semester 1, 2027, they must complete PLAN1030 and one additional level 2 Program Elective.
 - d. Completed one of PLAN1001 or PLAN2005, and the other course is no longer available, they must complete PLAN1030. The completed PLAN1001/PLAN2005 will then be counted as a Level 1/2 Program Elective.
